At the Hudson Area Public Library, we're celebrating the birthday of one of America's most cherished authors, Laura Ingalls Wilder, who would've turned 151 years old on February 7th. Her enduring series of Little House books continue to stir the imagination of generations of readers. We're honoring this Wisconsin-born writer with a series of events emphasizing authenticity. Events featured include a Laura cook-a-thon, Laura inspired crafts, a story time, book club and a special presentation entitled "Everything Laura Ingalls Wilder Left Out of Her Novels."

Engineering Design Challenge

On Saturdays, February 10th through March 3rd, the library is hosting an Engineering Design Challenge program for kids in grades 6-8. This special class is being offered by Christopher Mick from Space St. Croix with an Out of School Learning grant from the NASA Glenn Research Center. Using the engineering design process, students will design, build, and improve a standalone solar powered pumping system. Investigations will include building a solar-powered oven to learn about reflecting solar energy to heat up a tasty treat, learning how light intensity changes as you move away from the source and how lenses can be used to manipulate light.
